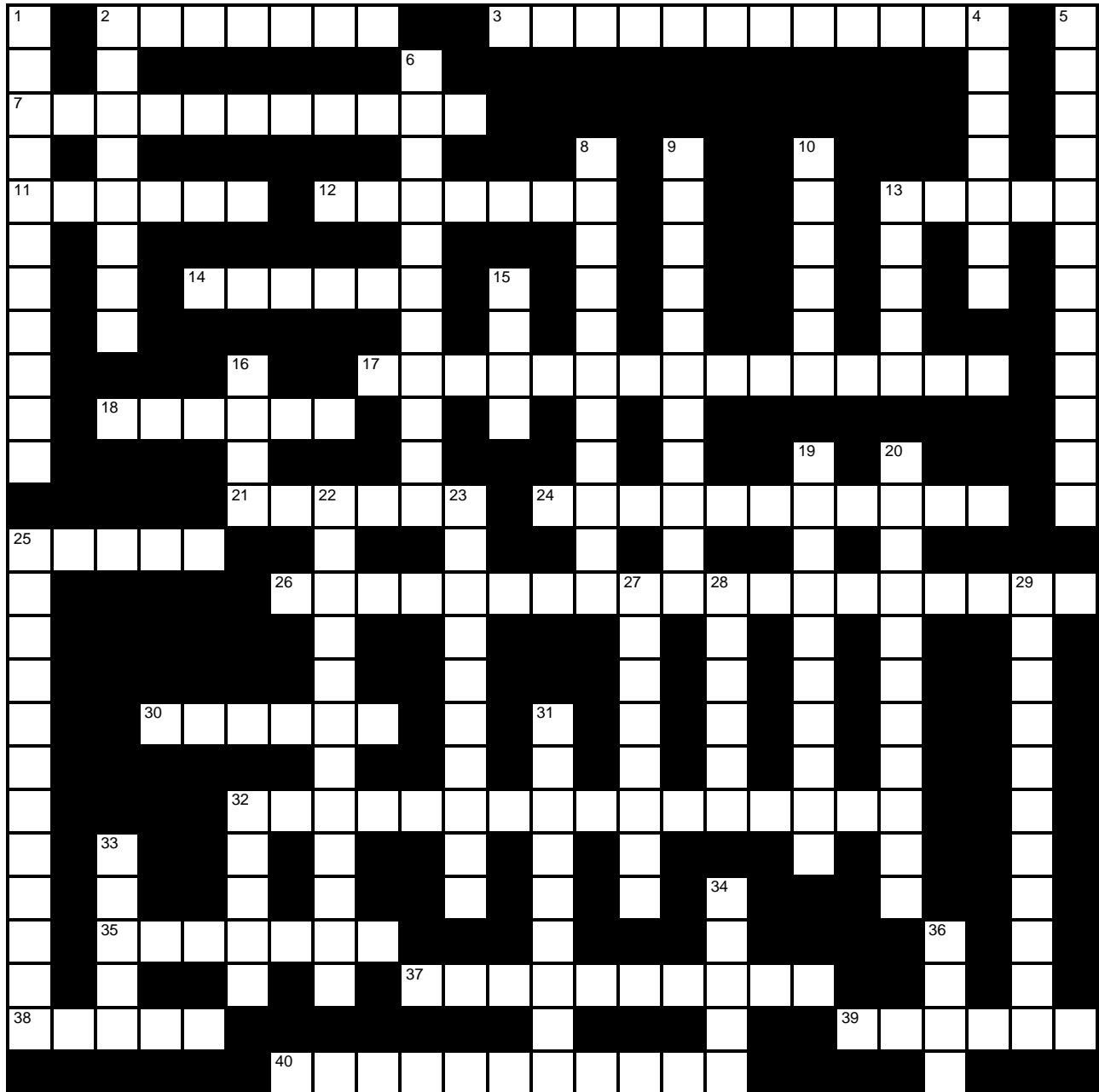
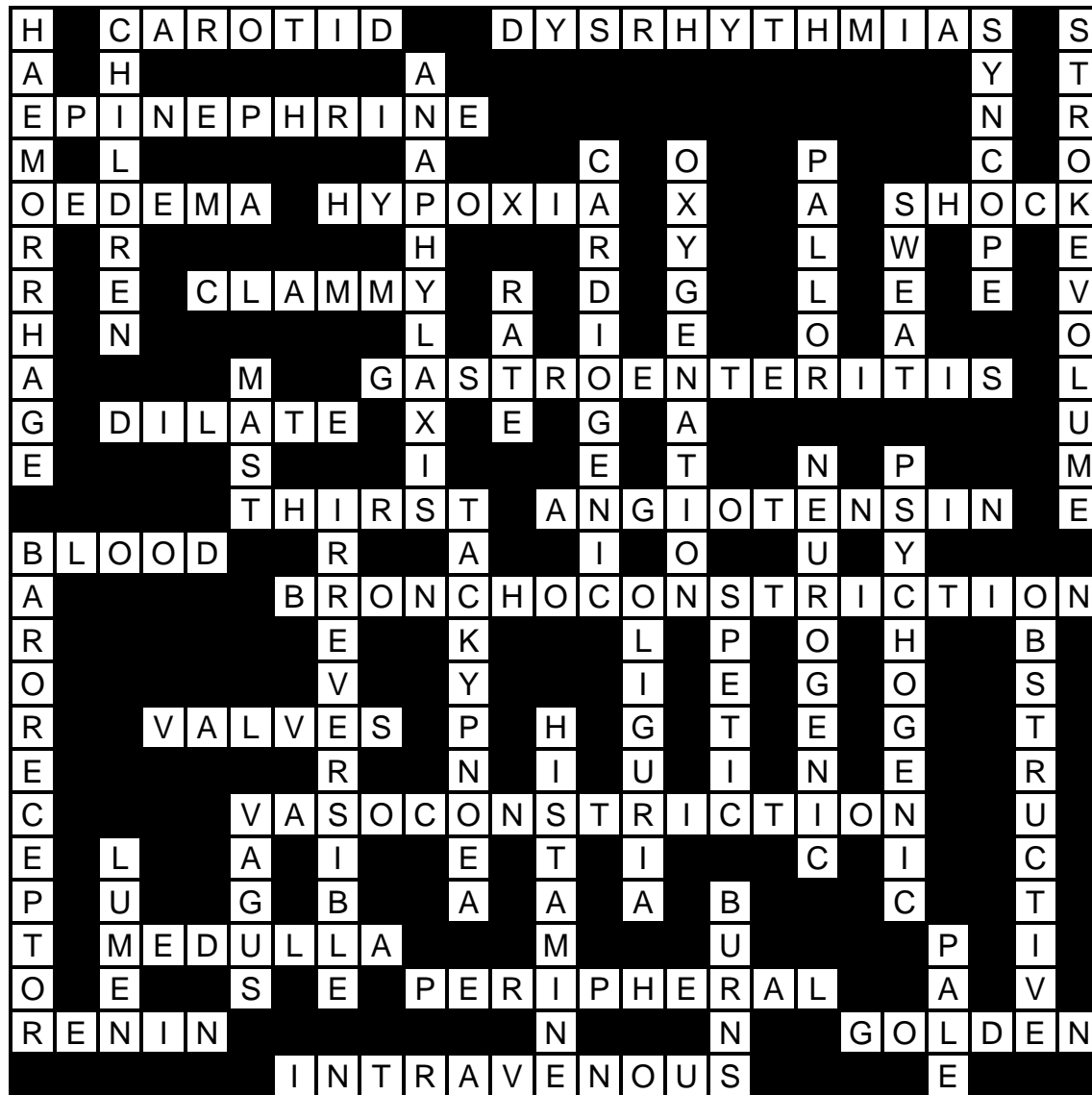


Shock
